Since it was introduced in 1996, more than six million treatments have been successfully performed in over 70 countries worldwide.

Though effects and treatment times vary depending on the patient's amount of volume loss and depth, width and length of the folds and creases, Restylane is easy to use by expert injectors and long lasting. Depending on where Restylane is injected, the effects can last years. The latest technique being used is called layering. Instead of just treating a wrinkle or a line, different products within the Restylane family (such as Perlane® or Restylane Fine Lines®) are

used to create the supporting structure under the wrinkle, and therefore bring back the volume which makes the wrinkle diminish.

Though it can be used to complement many different procedures - including Botox® and laser treatments such as resurfacing and IPL® [Photofacial] for sun damage - Restylane provides something that other treatments don't: Instead of changing your face it restores your natural beauty.
